The book club kits include up to 10 copies of the book from the ISRC library and a set of questions that can be used to guide book club discussions.

The books may also be checked out individually for personal reading, or may be checked out as a group for a student reading unit. A wide range of topics is covered by the books, including personal experience with deafness, Autism Spectrum Disorder, parenting a child who is deaf or hard of hearing, and behavior change strategies.
